General Information

ATS series line/generator switches are designed to automatically switch the on board 120 volt appliances to generator power when the generator is activated.

No longer do you need to go outside, remove the shoreline cord from the pole and plug it into the generator receptacle. Nor will you have to go to the breaker panel, manually shut off the shoreline mains, and then turn on the generator mains. Simply starting the generator activates the ATS, which will switch the loads for you.

Operation

After the **ATS 301 series** unit is installed, using one of the typical installations shown in this manual, it will be ready for years of trouble free service. Operation is automatic and no maintenance is required.

From Shoreline (All Models)

To operate appliances from shoreline power, simply plug in the shoreline cord to the power pole at the campground or dock. The ATS automatically connects all AC load panel appliances to shoreline power. Note, on 30 amp units with two air conditioners, only one will operate at a time because of the limits of the shoreline.

From Generator (All Models)

To operate appliances from the on board generator, simply start the generator.

After a typical 20 second delay to allow the generator output voltage to stabilize, the ATS will engage; transferring all AC load panel appliances to the generator output. The shoreline can remain plugged in as the ATS completely separates it from the system.

Mounting Locations

The **ATS 301 series** is not ignition protected; it may not be mounted in the same compartment as batteries or other flammable materials such as gasoline.


To minimize voltage drops in conductors, the ATS 301 series should be located close to the generator and shoreline cord entrance.

The ATS 301 may be used where appropriate to replace an existing 30 ampere Line/Generator switch attached at the back of a Parallax Power Supply 30 ampere AC input load center by simply installing the unit without the optional deck mount plate.

The **ATS 301** may be mounted in any position, leaving room for routing shoreline, generator and load (breaker panel) conductors.


The **ATS 301** series unit may be mounted in the cabin/living area or a basement compartment, but is not suitable for outside locations.

Typical Installations




ATS 301
