The module board must be mounted using a minimum of two mounting points at opposite diagonal corners of the board.

ALL SUBURBAN FURNACES <u>EXCEPT NT MODELS</u> can use the original mounting fasteners to secure the extension provided with this kit to the furnace.

NOTE: NT model furnaces MUST use the 3/8" Phillips head screw provided with this kit to secure the extension to the furnace.

FOR ALL FURNACE MODELS, reuse the original module board insulator between the board and the mounting surface and reuse the original cover over the board's spark coil tower.

INSTALLATION OF EXTENSION

- Determine which corner of the module board the extension will be secured to. See Figure 2.
- From under the board insert the plastic fastener up through extension and into center of the proper module board mounting leg until it stops. See Figure 1.
- 3. Place the module board on the furnace's module board mounting surface ensuring that the mounting leg that is being used and the hole through the center of the extension are aligned with the correct fastener locations. See Figure 2.

4. **SF, SH & DD17 MODEL FURNACES ONLY!**Use the original fasteners to secure the module board mounting leg and the extension to the furnace's mounting surface at both locations. See Figure 2.

NOTE: NT Model furnaces must use the 3/8" Phillips head screw supplied with this kit to secure the extension to the furnaces module board mounting surface. The original fastener may be used to secure the opposite mounting leg of the module board to the furnaces module board mounting surface.

CAUTION

- Exercise care to avoid breakage or damage to the module board when reinstalling the furnace into the metal cabinet.
- Substituting longer fasteners could penetrate the furnace chamber.

NOTE: On some units it may be possible to use one existing mounting hole or weld stud and nut.

Figures 1 and 2 are located on the reverse side of this instruction sheet.
